Eddie 'Kookaburra' Kneebone was instrumental in the development of Wodonga TAFE's Koori art program. He put much energy into encouraging Indigenous and non-Indigenous people of all ages to develop their artistic talents. Eddie was a prolific artist in his own right and Wodonga TAFE is proud to have had Eddie as its artist-in-residence from 1997 until his passing in 2005.

Eddie was a passionate force behind Wodonga TAFE's Koori art program, which has become an integral part of the fabric of Albury Wodonga's Indigenous community. Art students have participated in the program as a means to express and understand their unique culture, and to extend themselves personally. Many graduating artists have subsequently sold pieces across Australia and internationally.

The purpose of the Eddie 'Kookaburra' Kneebone Gallery is to extend the business capability of these students through formal training so that they can proactively market their art and earn a sustainable living from their gifts.
