NOTE: Applications need to be received by 6th January 2012. Places will be allocated by ballot after first round offers have been made. Only successful applicants will be notified. University applicants, please note, applications may be submitted from September 26th until 48 hours after first round offers are received. Applicants receiving second round offers may submit a late application. Early application is encouraged.

ON-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

There are 69 on-campus rooms available to students of La Trobe University and Wodonga Institute of TAFE. 43 rooms are available for La Trobe University students, and 26 rooms are available for Wodonga Institute of TAFE students. Priority is given to full-time first year VET or Higher Education Students, who are recent school leavers living away from home for the first time. Minimum age 17 on application.

Any offer of a room on campus is for one year only.

Security & Key Deposit.....\$300.00

This deposit is to cover the cost of any repairs to rooms once they are vacated and loss of key.

Rent\$ 121.00 (per week)

Rent may increase each year. The payment method is per **semester in advance**. The payment of rent includes the utilities costs, professional cleaning and Wifi internet access. Each student provides their own food. There is a cafeteria which provides low cost cooked meals through the day.

Activities Fee.....\$ 50.00

Facilities

There are twelve separate units, ten with six bedrooms and one with five bedrooms. One with four bedrooms is fully accessible to students with a physical disability. Each student has their own bedroom and shares the kitchen, laundry, bathroom and living area. Each unit is fully furnished and equipped with kitchen appliances. Students need to bring their own crockery, cutlery, bed linen, pillow and towels.

Rules and Regulations

Some basic rules exist to ensure that residents live in a safe and amenable environment. All residences are non-smoking areas, including bedrooms. No pets are permitted. Residents are expected to behave in a considerate and sensitive manner to other residents and their visitors.

OFF-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

As you may have realised, limited accommodation is available on-campus. The Wodonga TAFE Residential Co-ordinator can assist you to access affordable accommodation within the community. La Trobe University Student Services can also be contacted on (02) 6024 9847.

The Residential Co-ordinator can be contacted on (02) 6055 6389. There are various types of accommodation available. At the beginning of each year the competition for places is quite demanding. It is suggested that all students begin to investigate their options as early as possible.
