

Certificate III in Events

Course duration

This course is delivered in 26 weeks.

Course times

The course runs from Mondays to Fridays, between 9am and 5pm each day.

Outcomes

An Australian nationally recognized qualifications and a statement of attainment.

Estimated total course cost

The course costs AU\$4,550.

Your career in hospitality

Successful completion of this course may lead you to employment opportunities in administrative or operational events support roles in community, cultural, hospitality, sporting, and tourism sectors.

For example, you may find work as an event assistant, an event administrative assistant, an event operations assistant, a conference assistant, or an exhibitions assistant.

Course description

You develop basic interpersonal skills, food and beverage skills, basic event planning and registration skills, conference programming skills, and skills to support event staging.

On campus learning

Teachers will guide and support you in this course. On-campus sessions include presentations by selected industry experts who will share their knowledge and experiences. Presentations will be supported by relevant reading material, which may be used practically in the workplace.

Off-campus learning

This course also includes an off-campus work placement component, which involves each student undertaking 320 hours of placement during the year. Placements are divided into blocks. When on practical placement, students are required to be available as rostered by the placement provider (this involves shift work, but not night shift). Work placements are arranged by Wodonga TAFE with our industry partners.

Assessment process

Assessment is competency-based and comprises theoretical and practical assignments (which may include work-related projects), case studies, formal examinations, oral presentations, and practical experience.

Outcomes

If you successfully complete this course, you will be awarded the Certificate III in Events (SIT30607). This is a qualification from the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF). You will also receive a statement of attainment.

Pathways to further study

If you successfully complete this course, you may receive credits towards the Diploma of Events (SIT50207) which is also offered by Wodonga TAFE.

As a graduate, you may also receive credits to continue your studies at university.
