### Course duration

Each of these courses are delivered in 52 weeks. Together these two courses are delivered in 104 weeks.

### Course times

The course can run from 8am to 4.30pm, from Mondays to Wednesdays of each week, depending on practical training opportunities.

### Outcomes

Two Australian nationally recognized qualifications and a statement of attainment if you undertake both courses.

### Estimated total course cost

The course fees are payable as follows:

- Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics - Warehousing AU\$10,125, payable in your first year
- Diploma of Logistics AU\$10,480, payable in your second year

### Your career in transport and logistics

The transport and logistics industry continues to enjoy above average growth, as the economic effects of globalisation increase. Today, this industry is characterized by a highly technological environment with sophisticated conveyor picking and packing processes, and paperless records. Consequently, the industry requires highly skilled operators and managers.

As a graduate of the Diploma of Logistics, you can find employment opportunities in a range of sectors, including:

- customs and freight
- despatching and deliveries
- postal services
- warehousing and inventory
- road, rail and freight operations
- domestic and international airlines
- public transport.

Supply chain management encompasses the planning and management of all activities involved in sourcing and procurement of inputs and goods, conversion of the product as it moves along the chain, and all logistics management activities.

Logistics management is that part of supply chain management that plans, implements and controls the efficient forward and reverse flow and storage of goods, services and related information between the point of origin and the point of consumption in order to meet customers' requirements.

The Diploma of Logistics has been developed as a result of direct industry input. This Diploma may lead to management opportunities in the transport and distribution sectors, including as a supply chain and distribution manager, purchasing manager, logistics manager, warehousing manager, or third party logistics controller.



## Course description

In the first year, your learning pathway includes an understanding of how a warehousing and logistics operation functions in a safe team environment. You will learn how to move goods and operate stock movement processes, encompassing the roles of warehouse operators through to middle management roles.

In the second year, you will undertake the diploma component. This includes developing an understanding of the higher level operational, business and management requirements of a commercial logistics and supply chain operation.

## On campus learning

Trainers will guide and support you through this program. On-campus learning includes presentations by selected industry experts who will share knowledge and experiences. Presentations will be supported by relevant reading material, which may be used practically in the workplace.

The course also provides opportunities for you to investigate a number of good practice models in the local and metropolitan logistics and supply chain industries. These off-campus activities will add substantially to your professional profile.

## Assessment process

Assessment will include competency-based assessment comprising theory and practical assignments which may include reports relating to industry practices and relevant experiences from your workplace visits.

## Outcomes

If you successfully complete this course, you will receive a Diploma of Logistics and a Certificate IV in Transport and Logistics (Warehousing) which are Australian Qualification Framework qualifications. Each of these is nationally recognised and is accompanied by a statement of attainment.

## Pathways to further study

Successful completion of this course may take you to a full-year credit in higher level degree studies at university.
