

## Fairness Policy

Wodonga TAFE is committed to treating all of its students fairly. The application of fair treatment does not require that all students are treated the same. Fairness must be considered in the context of the relevant circumstances. There will be situations in which the fair treatment of students may result in varying circumstances being treated differently.

All students and members of the community are treated with dignity, courtesy and respect by Wodonga TAFE. As a VET provider Wodonga TAFE has open, fair and transparent procedures that are based on merit for making decisions about students undertaking, and persons applying for, courses.

Wodonga TAFE does not apply an income test when making decisions about Admission or eligibility for VET FEE-HELP.

Wodonga TAFE's VET Fairness Policy includes:

- VET tuition assurance
- requirements to appoint review officers, and
