### **Entry Requirements**

#### **VU20302\* Apply basic concepts of sustainability to own, or local, practice**

When you have successfully completed this unit, you will have a working knowledge of the key concepts of sustainability and be able to apply them to challenges in terms of environmental, economic, and social issues at global, national, and local levels.

#### **VU20303\* Develop and implement a program to support behaviour change for a sustainability initiative**

When you have successfully completed this unit, you will have a working knowledge of the key issues that affect individual and organisational behavioural change towards sustainable practices.



## **VU20304\* Develop a business plan for sustainable business practice**

When you have successfully completed this unit, you will have the knowledge and skills to develop a plan for responsive and sustainable business practice with a long-term view to the economic, environmental, and social impacts of the business.

## **VU20305\* Research and apply principles of sustainable production and consumption**

When you have successfully completed this unit, you will have explored and analysed the long-term effects and outcomes of sustainable production and consumption for business, the community, and government.
