



## ACMA Restricted/Open Cabling Registration

### OVERVIEW

Data and telecommunications infrastructure is more in-demand than ever! Any cabling that connects or is intended to connect to the telecommunications network must be carried out by a registered cabler. Successful completion of this course along with suitable experience will enable you to legally work in the telecommunications industry. This course is suitable for electricians, data cablers, telecommunications personnel, security/fire alarm installers, computer technicians, and cable TV installers who want to enter into the business of telecommunications cabling.
