



# HAZARDOUS AREA AUTHORITY

## OVERVIEW

A Hazardous Area Authority is required for drivers of vehicles that have 13 or more seats (including the driver) and who wish to drive in proclaimed 'hazardous areas' for the Victorian Alpine region during the snow season.

Holders of a Hazardous Area Authority (HAA) are only permitted to drive a vehicle for which they have undertaken hazardous area training. A HAA does not allow the holder to drive a vehicle if they do not have the appropriate driver licence category. **A HAA Refresher must be completed prior to Authority expiration.**

**Hazardous Area Authority Entry-Course:** This is a TWO DAY course for drivers that need to obtain their HAA endorsement. The opportunity to participate in HAA training is limited due to the short delivery window & small class numbers.

**Hazardous Area Authority REFRESHER:** This is a ONE DAY course for drivers that need to renew their HAA endorsement. We offer refresher training and assessment, as required by VicRoads. The opportunity to participate in HAA training is limited due to the short delivery window & small class numbers.

## ASSESSMENT

Students must pass both a written assessment and a practical driving assessment in order to successfully complete this course.
