Hold a current Australian Car Licence.

Vehicles must be safe, roadworthy, insured and registered.

Recommended: Generally it is better to train with the towable vehicle you plan to operate.

Please also note there are NO canteen facilities available at our Logic Campus. There are vending machines with limited options available and a BP Service Station located within 5 minutes' drive of the campus, otherwise bring your own food and drink when completing a course at our Logic Campus.
