DELIVERY METHODS

DURATION

Traineeship 12 - 18 months Part Time, training in classroom, via workshops and onsite mentoring. Public applicants, Part Time, 18 - 24 months, training in classroom, via workshops and onsite mentoring.

DELIVERY SCHEDULE

Variable depending on traineeship or non-traineeship arrangement.

REQUIREMENTS

You must have basic literacy skills and numeracy skills.

Trainees and non-trainees will require farm access.

You will be required to attend an interview prior to being accepted into the course.

You can be participating in a school-based program.

Applicants need to be able to participate in some strenuous physical activities.

FEES

From 1 January 2019, Free TAFE for Priority Courses is a Victorian Government program that will pay your tuition fees to study in this selected course at Wodonga TAFE, if you're eligible, subject to minimum numbers.
